

Parental Consent Form for
Administration of Potassium Iodide (“KI”) Pills

The New School, Inc. (TNS) is located 9.2 miles from the Shearon Harris nuclear power plant. In the event of a nuclear radiation emergency, the school has a supply of Potassium Iodide (“KI”) pills sufficient to give all students and TNS staff the approved dose. The KI pills would only be administered when directed by governmental authorities. TNS is required to have parents pre-elect whether or not to have KI pills (which are given orally) administered to their child in such an emergency. Information regarding Potassium Iodide and radiation absorption can be found in the pamphlet titled “Student Safety Information,” distributed by Progress Energy and found in the Parent Resource Center, located opposite the front desk in the office.
